
NEWS LETTER: SEMESTER I, 2025-26




















LANGUAGE CORNER-ENGLISH ACTIVITIES



Our English programme builds strong language foundations through engaging and interactive activities. Students explore alphabet learning, phonics, and communication skills via storytelling, picture talk, and rhymes. Action songs and hands-on activities like forming letters with clay and candy sticks make learning enjoyable. Flashcards help students frame CVC words, sort vowels and consonants, understand articles (A/An), and construct sentences. These comprehensive activities effectively foster reading, writing, and communication skills, creating confident young learners with a solid grasp of the English language.

































NUMERICAL ZONE-MATHS ACTIVITY



Our Mathematics program develops numerical literacy, problemsolving, and logical thinking through engaging hands-on activities. Students build strong foundations via rote counting, object counting, number sequencing, and simple addition. They explore concepts like reverse counting, comparing smaller and bigger numbers, understanding tens and ones, and identifying shapes. Interactive songs and activities make learning enjoyable while developing spatial awareness and mathematical reasoning. These comprehensive experiences equip young learners with essential numeracy skills and confidence to apply mathematics in real-life situations.































BASIC FACTS-GK ACTIVITIES



Our young learners explore the world around them through engaging Environmental Studies activities. Students develop self-awareness through lessons on self-introduction, safety, good habits, and self-care. They learn about their school and family environment while discovering the animal kingdom by sorting pictures based on habitats, food, homes, and identifying sounds through audio clips.
